. How to solve this, I do not want to install a previous version of this application. I have already tried: `sudo apt-get purge bcmwl*` and `sudo apt-get install bcmwl-kernel-source` and `sudo apt-get purge bcmwl*` and `sudo apt-get install b43-fwcutter b43-fwcutter-installer` or `sudo apt-get remove --purge bcmwl-kernel-source* sudo apt-get install --reinstall bcmwl-kernel-source sudo apt-get purge bcmwl-kernel-source*` A: It is not so easy to remove and install the driver, so you have to download the drivers with your internet connection. Here you will find the driver for your wireless card for Ubuntu 18.10 and then install the package with the following commands: `sudo apt-get update sudo apt-get install bcmwl-kernel-source sudo modprobe wl Q: log4j logging level depending on certain conditions I am trying to configure log4j logging levels to change depending on a certain condition. For example, there is a group of threads running in parallel. Depending on the amount of threads, I want to have 3 different levels of logging. In that case I want to have one log level for threads that are only running the tasks that come from one of the previous sub-tasks (A), one for the threads that are running the tasks that come from the same sub-task (A), and one for the threads that are running the tasks that come from all sub-tasks (B). But I cannot figure out how to accomplish this. If I use the %t option of log4j, I can easily see the content of the thread running a certain task, so I want to only log the task id if the content of the thread running that task does not look like a start task, so I can get it's parent task id. I tried this, but it does not work: 82157476af`
